Dear Editors,

I sincerely thank you for taking your time to examine my text.

I absolutely agree with your requirement that all articles sent to Encyclopedia Britannica should meet conditions fixed by the editorial office. When we write about psychology or psychiatry the text should be written within the framework of the scientific and biologic definition of the psyche submitted by Encyclopedia Britannica. Unfortunately, Encyclopedia Britannica does not have the definition of psyche - elementary comprehension of everything related to psyche - or standards that articles on psychology and psychiatry should meet. I believe that there should be some order fulfilled.

Upon my mind, nowadays there exists a possibility to convert the psyche from an abstract quantity to a material world.

First of all, there must be a definition of what psyche is (scientifically), and only then we can write about it, or themes related to it. Otherwise, it would be possible for anyone to interpret psyche in any popular way. This

could result in mistakes at early stage of the research and we can easily foresee the final result.

I would like to emphasize that originally I intended to post my text sent to you under the topic of psyche. Since in Encyclopedia Britannica such field is not available/present, I decided to post it under psychiatry. Thus, I understand your response. I am convinced that my text will be a fair contribution to your future definition of a psyche as a scientific field. Similarly as is my contribution to a definition of psyche in "Bolshaya Sovetskaya Entsiklopediya" (<http://www.enci.ru/w/index.php?title=Психика&oldid=39648804>). Note, that the version sent to you is already upgraded. The new, upgraded definition contributes to better understanding of the origins and mechanisms of depression, schizophrenia, etc.

I expect that the future contributions on psyche, psychology and psychiatry will be written in accordance with biological rules and principles - rules of organization of the functions in living systems (<http://www.springerlink.com/content/r262508p06481056/?p=c4c4e9065ef0420fbb8f3c0336e01f4b&pi=13&MUD=MP>). Due to understanding of these biological rules and principles we can avoid the possible mistakes already in the field of theory.

that is based on good start and will also be beneficial to Encyclopedia Britannica.

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Psychic activity is determined as a choice of priority forms of activity at the moment governed by the genetic information, information accumulated by living system during the lifespan, information received at given moment from outside and information being received and generated inside the system at the moment. This priority form of activity is defined by means of comparison of information being received at moment with information saved in the system.

By the other words, psyche is a set of adaptive reactions of a living system determined by both genetic information and information on conscientious and non-conscientious levels contained in all sorts of memory. Psyche influences the physiological state of the system (calculations processing, imagination, intuition etc). Actually, it is the interference of various information flows from different sources that determines the choice and character of activity.
